Questions to Dig Deeper:

- 1. James says that pride and selfishness are the root of most conflict. What does this stir up in you?
- 2. Two gutters in conflict are winning at all costs and losing track of what your hoped outcome. Do you find yourself struggling with one or both of those in challenging conversations?
- 3. Where have seen a positive, Christ-like example of pride like in 2 Corinthians 7:4, and where have seen the harmful kind of pride like James highlights in chapter 4?
- 4. Name a relationship or community that submission comes naturally, and name one where it is challenging.
- 5. Our big idea today was: Mature believers know that peace starts with me. Name one place or relationship that you can work to bring God's shalom.
