## Questions to **Dig Deeper**:

- 1. What is one way you have seen prayer modeled? What does it look like? Is this a way that you pray? What do you find more beneficial about praying in this way?
- 2. When you think about God, what characteristics would you list for God? God is.... what?
- 3. Today we talked about a few ways to talk with God: gratitude, lament, intercession, petition. Which of those comes most naturally for you in prayer? What is it that you want to grow in?
- 4. "It's an open secret that many Christians find prayer boring; one reason for that is because they aren't praying; they're performing. We are so used to performing our life with other people; we edit our thoughts; to present a more polished image of ourselves to the world; to be loved, and not rejected, and succeed and not fail. It's like we can't help but carry that way of being over into our relationship to God." How does this quote resonate with what prayer feels looks like for you?
