Isaiah 9:2-7

Questions to Dig Deeper:

- 1. Isaiah's imagery talks about the hope that the light of Jesus will be after a period of darkness. When have you seen or sensed God in the midst of a trying time?
- 2. In verse 6, Isaiah uses 4 phrases to describe Jesus: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. Of those four, which one do you most draw to? What about least drawn to and why?
- 3. The people of Isaiah knew well the temptation of placing their hope into something or someone other than God. Who or what in your life creates that temptation for you?
- 4. A core trait of Jesus was bringing about justice. What is one place in this world where you pray to see justice flowing as our passage speaks about?
