Questions to Dig Deeper:

- 1. Why do you think God instructed the Israelites to build a memorial from the stones of the Jordan River? What does this teach us about remembering and telling our stories of God's faithfulness?
- 2. In Joshua 4:6-7, it says the stones are to be a sign so that future generations will ask about them. What are some "stones" or moments in your life that you think God wants you to remember and share with others?
- 3. How can sharing our personal stories of God's work in our lives strengthen the faith of others? Have you ever been encouraged by someone else's testimony?
- 4. What keeps us from sharing our stories of faith—especially the hard or vulnerable parts? How might God want to use even those parts for His glory?
- 5. If you were to set up a "memorial stone" today, what event or moment of God's faithfulness would it represent? How can you share that story with someone this week?
