Questions to Dig Deeper:

- 1. Rahab expresses faith in the God of Israel before she ever meets the Israelites in person (verse 11). What does this teach us about faith and how it can grow even before full understanding?
- 2. Rahab made a bold decision to protect the spies, risking her life and going against her own people. What can we learn from her courage when it comes to standing up for what we believe in?
- 3. How does the fear of the Lord described by Rahab (verses 9-11) compare to how people respond to God today? What role should a healthy fear or reverence of God play in our faith?
- 4. How might Rahab's story encourage us to take bold steps of faith, especially when the outcome is uncertain or risky?
- 5. What role does listening play in Rahab's story? (She heard about what God had done and responded in faith.) How well are we listening to what God is doing around us—and how might that lead us to action?
