## Questions to Dig Deeper:

- 1. How do you see God's love expressed toward Hagar and Ishmael in this passage, even as they are sent away?
- 2. In verse 17, God hears the boy crying. What does this reveal about God's awareness of our pain and struggles?
- 3. Hagar experiences deep fear and despair in the wilderness. How does God's presence change her situation, and how might that speak into our own seasons of hardship?
- 4. What does the opening of Hagar's eyes to the well (v.19) teach us about God's provision and care in the midst of difficulties?
- 5. How does God's promise to make Ishmael into a great nation ( $\nu$ .13,  $\nu$ .18) demonstrate His love beyond human plans or expectations?
- 6. In what ways can we, as a community of faith, reflect God's love and presence to those who feel cast out or overlooked, like Hagar and Ishmael?
