



"Ask God The Hard Questions. Grow."

Matthew 7:7-10

1 Corinthians 3:1-9

Questions to **Dig Deeper**:

Matthew 7 invites us to ask, seek, and knock. How comfortable are you with bringing your questions, doubts, or uncertainties to God? What practices help you stay open to God's unexpected answers?

Bill warned about creating "manufactured certainty" to calm our nerves. In what ways have you seen Christians (including yourself) trade genuine faith for oversimplified answers? How can we stay humble while holding to core truths?

In 1 Corinthians 3, Paul reminds the church that their growth is God's work, not the result of any one leader. How do you see God using the gifts of others in your church community? What role do you play in helping others stay rooted?

Bill mentioned how easy it is to become rooted in politics, causes, or preferences instead of God. Where are you most tempted to put your ultimate trust or identity outside of Christ? What helps you re-center yourself on God?

Being rooted in Christ is not just a belief but a way of life. What is one practical step you can take this week to deepen your roots in wonder, community, or God Himself?
