

Questions to *Dig Deeper*:

How does seeing God fulfill His promises in Scripture help build your trust in Him today, especially in a world where trust in institutions is so low? Can you think of a time when God has proven Himself faithful in your own life?

What does it mean to you that God's redemption plan was embodied—that He came to us in person? What might it look like for us to "show up" for others in tangible, incarnational ways this Advent season?

Why do you think mercy is such an important part of God's character? How can we become better ambassadors of God's mercy—especially toward people who frustrate or differ from us?

In what ways do you find yourself still trying to prove your worth—to God or to others? How might embracing God's forgiveness change the way you live and relate to others?

What does it mean for you to live as a person of hope in your family, workplace, or community? How can our church embody this hope together in a world that feels jaded and weary?
