Questions to *Dig Deeper*:

Which character do you most resonate with right now—the younger son, the older son, or the father—and why? How might that reveal something about how you’ve been formed by experiences of love?

The older son believes love must be earned and measured. Where do you see that mindset shaping the church or your own faith today?

Luke 15:31–32 shows the father going out to both sons. What does that tell us about how God responds to both rebellion and self-righteousness?

How does fear—of scarcity, loss, or approval—limit our ability to love radically? Where might God be inviting you to release fear in order to love more freely?

What would it look like for our church or small group to “join the celebration” of God’s grace? Who might God be calling us to welcome, even when it feels uncomfortable or undeserved?
