Questions to *Dig Deeper*:

1. Where do you see ways that sincere faith can still be shaped by fear, control, or certainty rather than grace? How do we stay open to God correcting our picture of Him?
2. What does this tell us about where and how God's grace often shows up in our own lives? Can you name a moment when grace interrupted you rather than rewarded you?
3. What are some ways our assumptions about God, others, or ourselves can keep us from truly seeing? What practices or postures help us move toward clearer spiritual sight?
4. Why do you think God so often extends grace through other people? Who has been an "Ananias" to you, and who might God be inviting you to be an Ananias for right now?
5. How does Paul's story challenge the way you view difficult people in your life—co-workers, family members, neighbors, or even groups you disagree with? What might it look like for grace, not fairness, to shape those relationships?
