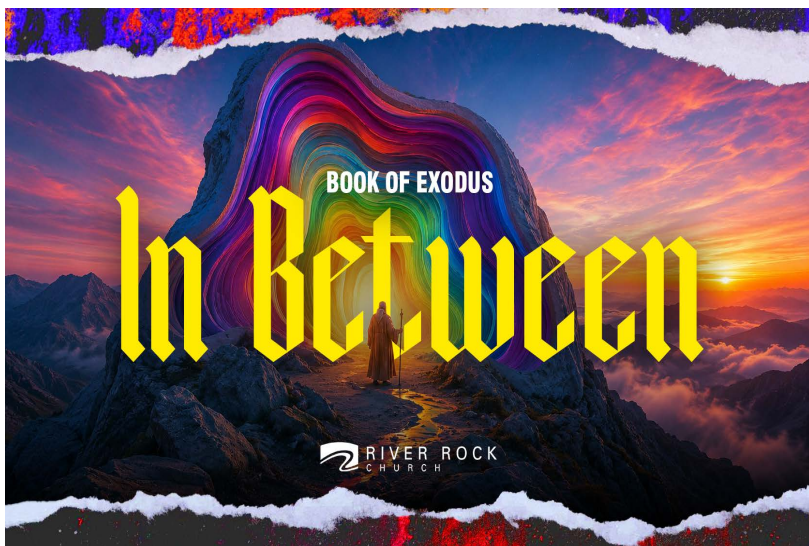

Exodus Series "The In Between" Exodus 1

Questions to *Dig Deeper*:

1. Bill talked about the “in-between” as the space between where we are and where we hope to be. What is a season of “in-between” you have experienced in your own life, and what did it reveal about you?
2. The Hebrew midwives “feared God more than Pharaoh.” What do you think gave them the courage to act faithfully in such a dangerous situation? What are some modern-day situations where Christians may need similar courage and integrity?
3. Bill named that suffering and uncertainty often reveal our true character rather than the version of ourselves we try to present. How have difficult seasons shaped or exposed your faith, priorities, or dependence on God?
4. Exodus 1 can feel like a story where God is silent or absent, yet God is quietly at work through ordinary people and unexpected circumstances. Why is it often hard to recognize God’s presence during painful or uncertain seasons? How can we learn to trust God when we cannot yet see deliverance?
5. The sermon ends by reminding us that some of the holiest moments happen “before the miracle comes” — through everyday choices. What everyday places is God inviting you to see Him and work, and be part of that right now? What might faithfulness look like for you in this season?
