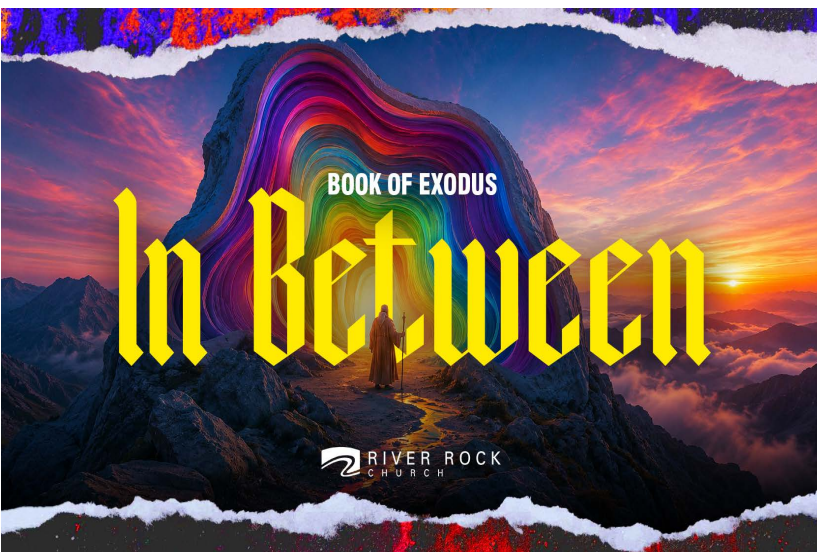

Exodus Series "The In Between"

Exodus 12

Questions to *Dig Deeper*:

1. When you find yourself in a difficult "in-between" season, what are you most tempted to trust instead of God (your own plans, control, money, approval from others, certainty, etc.)? How does this passage challenge those instincts?
2. Can you think of a time when you believed you were following God's leading but didn't see the results you expected? What helped you keep trusting, or what made trusting difficult?
3. Why do you think God established the Passover before Israel left Egypt? How does knowing that we belong to God change the way we walk through seasons of waiting and uncertainty?
4. What are some "reminders" God has given you of His faithfulness—a story, a person, a verse, a place, a journal entry, or even an ordinary object? How have those memories strengthened your faith during difficult seasons?
5. Bill ended with the challenge to reflect on and remember what God has done. What would it look like this week to intentionally remember what Christ has done for you instead of allowing fear, disappointment, or uncertainty to shape your perspective?
